ANNUAL REPORT - 2015-2016

Our first batch of class XII has made us very proud with its results. 9 students scored above 90 in different subjects. 2 students scored above 93% in 4 subjects. The best performance was in Business Studies where most of our students got 98% of marks. 5 students scored 10 CGPA in our third batch of X, 26 students above 9.2 CGPA. All the students of the Board exams passed with first class. This year the five 10 CGPA scorers received a personal congratulatory letter from the Honourable Minister for Human Resource Development, Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani. A letter of compliment from Madam Minister was also personally received by me and this is now two year in succession.

The academic year began with Orientation programmes for teachers and parents. Film Festival Week was celebrated early this year. Seminars and workshops for teachers were organized throughout the year. Mrs. Raji Shankaran attended ASL workshop conducted by the CBSE. Primary students won three 1st prizes in Radio Mirchy – Pothy's competition. Students won four 1st prizes, three 2nd prizes and one 3rd prize in competitions conducted by KMR School. In competitions conducted by NPR group of colleges, students won 1st prize in Hair Do and 2nd prize in Group Western and Group Classical dance. 35 students of various classes participated in Velammal Choir Christmas Carols-"Chiming Bells" inter schools competition and our team bagged the first prize. 4 of our students have scored high marks in Spell Bee competition conducted by Spell Bee International. Our students have also participated in Inter House Kho Kho, Throw Ball and Volley Ball matches. Cherish Rajpurohit won Miss Talent Award in RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) conducted by CESCI. In Bharathiyar Competition conducted by Thambras, our children bagged one 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize each in Poetry Recitation and Elocution.
