Annual Reports: 2020-21

Ladies and gentlemen, good evening! We, Aruna M Visvessvar and Rincy Jose, stand before this august assembly, proud and privileged to present the report of two successful years of Adhyapana School.

Academics at Adhyapana

- o Board exam results for the academic year 2019-20 R K Raaga Nandhini of Std XII from the Science group scored 486/500 and was the school topper.
- In Std X, C.Akshadha Angel 489/500 was the school topper. Akshadha Angel has been awarded CBSE Board's Merit Scholarship for her outstanding results.
- AKS Education's School Toppers' Award was bestowed upon Std X School Topper Akshadha Angel and Subject Toppers V Jaswanthni for English, R Akshara for Sanskrit and P Tejomathy for Science.
- o 119 out of 125 students in grade XII received above-75% distinction, as did 91 out of 119 students in grade X. Once again, the outcomes were absolutely fantastic, with **six students achieving centum** in various subjects.

General Activities at School:

- ➤ Our School has been rewarded for its STEM teaching (STEM being Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) by NITI Aayog of the Central Government by way of a **Grant of Rs.20 Lakhs for setting up the Atal Tinkering Lab.** This lab has been since inaugurated and caters to the teaching of Robotics, AI, Bio and Nano Technologies.
- ➤ It gives us great pleasure to announce that Adhyapana School is the **proud recipient of SASTRA-CNR RAO Lab.** We are one among 10 schools only selected out of more than a hundred competitive entries from India by Sastra Deemed University.
- ➤ The School is now entirely **Solar Power Generated.** In keeping with our tradition of Energy Conservation and Environmental Protection giving us the **National Green School award.**

Despite the sudden outbreak of pandemic that forced all the educational institutes to remain closed temporarily, Adhyapana is the first school in Madurai to succeed in shifting entirely to online teaching - A panacea in the time of Covid-19 crisis.

From April 2020 onwards until the reopening of school for all Standards, general activities at the school underwent a paradigm change from offline to online using Google Meet and G-Suite.

- In support of the Government's efforts to combat Covid-19, all our Staff members lit the candles and lights to spread the message of stay home stay safe. 2019-20 batch shared the corona awareness messages through a collage work.
- 2. A **Tamil skit** on Corona Awareness ably guided by the Heads of the Primary School along with our Tamil teacher Mr.Baskara Pandian was enacted by our Primary students.

- 3. A **Corona Awareness Song** well-executed by Mrs. Rincy Jose, directed by Mr. Godson Jerone, Music by Mr. Franklin Nickson, Recording assistance by Mr.Suresh and written by me with our Dean sir's support was released and is on YouTube.
- 4. Std VIII students performed **Voice and Vision** on this Song choreographed by Dance Master Sam.
- 5. Adhyapana School contributed Rs.25000 towards our **C.M relief fund** for Covid operations.
- 6. 'Away from Books'- Non-academic activities on different value based topics was conducted every day to engage all the students during the lockdown days. The school and staff went beyond their call of duty to conduct diverse and engaging classes such as Healthy Cooking, Singing, Dance, Simple Hair-do, Pattern Drawing, Cookery, Learning Thirukural, Spoken Hindi, Spoken English and many more. Course completion certificates were issued too.
- 7. Career Guidance Online session was conducted exclusively for the students of Stds IX to XI. Students also received their E-certificate for attending the session.
- 8. Pongal, International Yoga Day, Father's Day, Quit India Movement Day, National Sanskrit Day, World Photography Day, Teacher's Day, Gandhiji and Sastriji's Birthday, Children's Day were all celebrated **online and over Google Meet.**
- 9. **Student Elections** were conducted for the Student Council under the supervision of the School Heads.
- 10. For the 1st time, in the history of any educational institution, Sports Day was conducted on-line and received much publicity on the media and newspapers. 12th year Sports Day was inaugurated by our life trustees Mr.Praveen Visesh and Mrs.Aparna Praveen from Singapore for the Primary Sports Meet. Mrs. Bubbles, CEO, Zadokz Institute inaugurated the Senior Sports Meet. The telecast of the same was done on many TV channels like Polimer NEWS, J NEWS &Thanthi TV. NEWS about our on-line Sports meet was published in Malayala Manorama paper, Chennai Edition.
- 11. **Installation Ceremony of the Interact Club** was held virtually and their first launch was **Toy Bank** and **United We String projects**. Also, distributed **hand sanitizers and masks** to the support staff of our school as its charity project.
- 12. The **Installation ceremony** of the first-ever team of office bearers of the **Early Act Club** was done online and as the First Project, **a story-telling workshop** was organized for Std V. Organised 'The **Camlin Abstract Painting Workshop**' for the students to learn the techniques of drawing. To commemorate Mental Wellness week a webinar on 'A Roadmap To Life Skills & Mental Wellness' was organized by Early Act Club.
- 13. The **74th Independence Day** was observed in two parts with a slight twist. Both the first and second parts were live broadcast on **YouTube and Google Meet**, respectively. **Mr. Michael Block**, the Principal of Kananook Primary School, Melbourne, Australia served as the Chief Guest. Additionally, Our Independence Day news was included in the **Chennai edition of Malayala Manorama**.

- 14. On **Hindi Divas** I inaugurated virtual Hindi class and assigned Mrs. Rugmini V Menon as teacher-in-charge for one of our partner schools Kananook Primary School, Melbourne, Australia.
- 15. **School reopened** after 10 months of lockdown with all the safety protocols put in place for Std X & XII on **19**th **January 2021.** Stds IX and XI commenced on **8**th **Feb 2021.**
- 16. National Science Day and Fit India School Week were celebrated with gusto.

Subject Week Celebration
